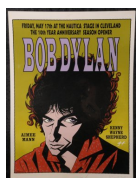

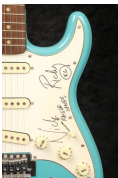

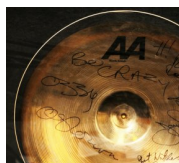

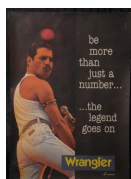

Queen: Promo poster for the album 'The Show Must Go On', deleted and destroyed poster, rolled NB: This poster was designed to promote one of the last singles that was released when Freddie Mercury was still alive. Once the poster had been printed the management decided it should be destroyed, as the wide black border around it looked more like a mourning advertisement than a promotional poster which just didn't seem or feel right given the circumstances.

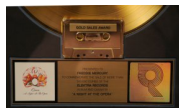

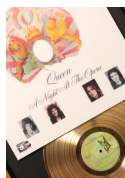

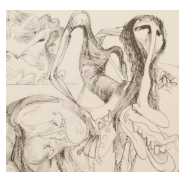

These awards from the record company were due to be presented to the band during their USA tour however the show was cancelled due to Brian May contracting hepatitis as was the entire tour and the presentation never took place. The awards were stored and found 25 years later and have been kept together ever since.

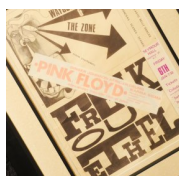

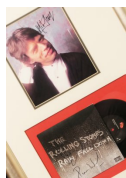

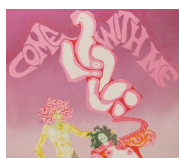

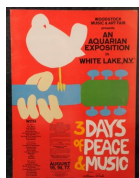

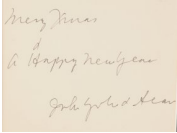

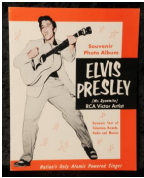

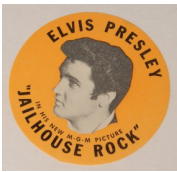

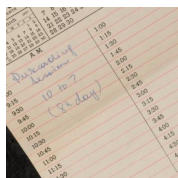

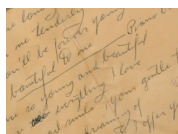
